Introduction:

2011 will see the first African launch of the world's biggest celebrity lifestyle publication, OK! Magazine Nigeria. First launched in 1993, this hugely successful global celebrity gossip and news magazine has well over 30 million readers worldwide and is currently published in 19 countries: soon to be 20 with its arrival in Nigeria.

The man bringing OK! Magazine to Nigeria and Africa for the first time is leading entrepreneur, Alexander Amosu, who turned his interest in technology and the mobile phone industry into a commercial success story. He became a millionaire at the age of 25 in his first year of entering the ringtones arena when he launched RnB Ringtones. Alexander's passion for technology, and his entrepreneurial skills and determination resulted in him being one of the top 100 most influential black people in Britain.

He has been ranked number 98 in the Telegraph's list of the UK's most powerful people in technology and telecoms, was featured in the Sunday Times 'top 40 under 40' in the UK, and was also named by Powerlist 2008 as one of the 50 most influential black males in Britain. Having appeared in the Nigerian version of the BBC's Dragons' Den investing in other people's businesses, Alexander Amosu's most recent business venture has included launching a luxurious fashion and accessories line. As part of the new luxury line, Amosu created the world's most expensive suit which was launched to critical acclaim in London, UK (2009), and Lagos, Nigeria and Tokyo, Japan (2010).

Alexander Amosu now plans to continue with the global success of OK! Magazine and its reputation for exclusive interviews, weddings, engagements and pregnancies of top celebrities by emulating this winning format, featuring mainly celebrities from Nigeria as well as leading people from ethnic minorities around the world who are highly respected within the African continent.



The Launch Event:

The launch of OK! Magazine Nigeria will take place in June 2011 in two cities, Lagos and London.
